n Evening on a Musical Magic Carpet

Embassy of Türkiye | November 29th, 2024

usic took a magic carpet ride as it crossed paths at the geographic intersection of West and East!

The occasion: a memorable late November chamber concert evening at the Embassy of Türkiye. As our host, H.E. Ambassador Can Dizdar and his wife Demet Dizdar warmly welcomed fifty-five Friends of the National Arts Centre Orchestra, and Turkish colleagues to their elegant Rockcliffe Park residence.

In the masterful hands of the internationally acclaimed Turkish music duo, Yahya Geylan and Canan Sezgin Geylan, and three steller Canadian musicians: NACO violinist Emily Westell; cellist Desiree Abbey and flutist Sean Clarke, who combined their formidable talents in trio mode, the cross-cultural compass set a west to east course for an hour of music magic.

Focussing on selections in the European tradition, the Westell/Abbey/Clarke threesome, opened with Beethoven's Minuet in G Major followed by Telemann's Trio Sonata in C minor and Bach's concerto in D minor.

Changing pace, the trio delivered the happy sounds of Haydn's London Trio and the Gavotte movement from Grieg's Holberg Suite before rounding out their segment of the program with the Allegro movement from Jean Baptiste Breval's Trio Opus 8; Rimsky-Korsakov's haunting Scheherazade theme and Dvorak's Humoresque.

The soundscape then shifted dramatically as the Duo Canan Sezgin Geylan and Yahya Geylan took the audience of music devotees through time and space to the Europe-Asia crossroads for an encounter with the hypnotic soundscapes of classical Turkish 'Makam', the ancient melodic framework in which tetrachords and pentachords join to create complete scales and many different melodic modes.

Interestingly, several of the ancient melodic modes have time-travelled well through the centuries to become favourites in contemporary Turkish music. The Duo Geylan treated the audience to an engaging sampling of the Makam tradition, playing their traditional instruments while singing the sometimes wistful, other times soulful lyrics of classical Turkish 'Makam'.

For a program finale, all five musicians combined their formidable talents for a pitch perfect mingling of European and traditional Turkish instruments playing a medley of selections in the Turkish classical 'Makam' framework; following which, Ambassador Dizdar cordially invited everyone to join him in the embassy's spacious reception room to sample kebabs and other Turkish culinary specialties. A truly special evening of cultural diplomacy at its best!
